1. Eligibility:

- Candidates should have passed Intermediate Examination (10+2 pattern) or any examination recognized as equivalent thereto by the Board of Intermediate Examination, Telangana State with the following subjects: (a) Biology (b) Physics (c) Chemistry Or (a) Mathematics (b) Biology (c) Physics (d) Chemistry or (a) Mathematics (b) Physics (c) Chemistry

Note: Irrespective of the subjects taken at the qualifying examination, candidate seeking admission to the B.Sc. (Hons.) Forestry course should have appeared and qualified in TS EAMCET-2023.

Note: Proof of satisfying the marks criteria in the qualifying examination in respect of candidates who appeared for the examination during the year of admission should be furnished at the time of admissions.

2. Criteria for selection:

- The selection of candidates for all the seats shall be made on the basis of ranks obtained by the candidates in the Telangana State **EAMCET-2023** conducted by the JNTU, on behalf of the **Telangana State Council of Higher Education (TSCHE)**.

3. Age:

- The candidates for admission into B.Sc. (Hons.) Forestry course shall be required to have completed 17 years of age with an upper age limit of 22 years for all the candidates, 25 years in respect of SC and ST candidates; and 27 years for Physically Challenged candidates as on 31st December of the year of admission.

4. Reservation of seats for various streams

- 25% of the regular seats to MPC/MBiPC stream students who have qualified in the Telangana State Engineering Agriculture and Medicine Common Entrance Test (TSEAMCET 2023).
- The remaining 75% of seats will be allocated to BiPC stream students based on their TSEAMCET 2023 scores.
- After two rounds of seat allotment for MPC stream, vacant seats if any, shall be converted to BiPC stream students

5. Reservation Policy for Admission

The admission will be purely based on merit and the reservation roster of the State Government of Telangana in vogue.

As per the statutory provisions followed in State of Telangana

- a. 85% of the seats are reserved for local candidates and 15% of seats are unreserved.
- b. Backward Classes: 29% of seats are reserved under this category.
(BC-A – 7%; BC-B – 10%; BC-C – 1%; BC-D – 7%; BC-E – 4%)
- c. Scheduled Caste (SC): 15% & Scheduled Tribe (ST): 10%
- d. EWS: 10%
- e. Reservation of seats for Women: In the course, 33.3% of the seats shall be reserved in favor of women candidates from each category.

Other Reservations:

- a. Children of Armed Forces Personnel (CAP) - 2%
- b. National Cadet Corps. (NCC) - 1%
- c. Games & Sports - (0.5%)
- d. Physically Challenged - 3% (1% for Visually Handicapped; 1% for Hearing Impaired, 1% for Orthopedically Handicapped).

2. Residential Certificate:

- Applicants who have a gap/break in the years of study for reasons other than failure or those who passed the qualifying examination by private study have to submit this certificate issued by the Tahsildar. In case, the applicant has resided in more than one place, separate certificate from the Tahsildar, should be furnished for such places of residence.

3. Hostel facility:

- Compulsory residential program and rooms shall be provided subject to the availability of accommodation.

4. Dress code:

- Light blue shirt and Dark Blue trouser for boys and Light blue Kameez and Darkblue salwar & Dupatta for girls.

5. Original certificates to be produced at the time of Admission:

- Secondary School Certificate (S.S.C.) / 10th standard. certificate as a proof of Date of Birth.
- 10+2/ Intermediate marks memo.
- Community Certificate for SC, ST, EWS and BC candidates as per G.O. Ms. No. 58, Social Welfare (J) Dept, dated 12.5.1997 issued by MRO / Tahsildar.
- Proof of Local/ Non-Local status of the candidates - according to rules in force those who have studied for at least four consecutive academic years ending with the first appearance in the qualifying examination as regular students need to submit only the Bonafide certificates from the colleges/ schools where they have studied. In case the candidates have studied four consecutive years preceding the qualifying examination in more than one local area, the candidates must submit the Bonafide certificate(s) of at least seven consecutive academic years ending with the first appearance in the qualifying examination as regular students. In case the candidates have not studied in any educational institution during part of 4/7 years preceding the qualifying examination, they have to submit a certificate to that effect from the concerned Mandal Revenue Officer / Tahsildar.
- TS EAMCET – 2023 Rank Card and Hall Ticket.
- F.C.R.I. Registration Form applied online.

6. Fees:

- The particulars of fees are given here under. The candidates who are granted admission have to pay the prescribed fees immediately at the time of admission.

Note: 1. In case of partial fee payment / non-payment of fee (for both regular and payment), the candidate shall have no right to ask for seat and it shall be allotted to the next candidate in merit.
2. No refund is applicable in case of students cancelling admissions after the admission process is completed, as the seat cannot be filled up further.
